


- M: As we prepare to celebrate the mystery of Christ's love, let us confess our sin and ask the Lord for pardon and strength:

The choir sings the verse. The congregation repeats the last phrase as printed below.


- 1. Lord Jesus, you came to heal all blindness: Lord, have mercy.
