Gathering Rite: Lead Us to Your Light

The opening hymns and songs of Christian worship mean to "gather" individual Christians into a worshiping assembly. What the traditional service does with hymns, canticles, and opening liturgy, this Advent gathering rite does with contemporary song and responses.

LEAD US TO YOUR LIGHT

The choir introduces the refrain. Then the congregation repeats the refrain and sings it again as indicated.



Lord, we await your coming to our world; Bring us the gift of salvation. *refrain*

Lord, you are hope and healing for our world; Come, now, and bring us your good news. *refrain*

Come, O come, O come, Emmanuel; Come with us on earth here to dwell. *refrain*

Rouse us from sleep, wake us from our slumber; Banish the darkness of night. *refrain*

Child of the light and love beyond all telling, Fill our hearts with wonder and praise. *refrain*

M: In the name of the Father and of the Son and of the Holy Spirit.




M: The grace of our Lord ¥ Jesus Christ, and the love of God, and the fellowship of the Holy Spirit be with you.



LORD, HAVE MERCY

M: The Lord Jesus comes to us and offers his grace and love. It is good for us to repent of our sins and to plead for his mercy.

Lord Jesus, you came to gather the nations into the peace of God's kingdom because all have turned away from you. Lord, have mercy.



M: You come in Word and Sacrament to strengthen us in holiness. Yet we fill our days and lives with busyness. We do not make time for your Word and Sacrament. Christ, have mercy.



M: You will come in glory with salvation for your people. Make us ready through the blood of Jesus to meet you with uplifted faces. Lord, have mercy.



M: May almighty God, have mercy on us, forgive our sins, and bring us to everlasting life. Amen.



ABSOLUTION

M: The almighty God has been merciful to us and has sent his Son to die for all. For his sake, he forgives us our sins and calls us from darkness to his marvelous light. Therefore, as a called servant of Christ and by his authority, I forgive you all your sins in the name of the Father and of the Son ▼ and of the Holy Spirit.

PSALM 6 (page 66)

M: Lord God, you are merciful and tenderhearted, abounding in love and faithfulness. Turn to us in our anguish over sin and hear our cry for mercy that we may be at peace; through your Son, Jesus Christ our Lord.

SCRIPTURE LESSON

Isaiah 59:1-4, 7-9, 12-20

Surely the arm of the Lord is not too short to save, nor his ear too dull to hear.

But your iniquities have separated you from your God;

your sins have hidden his face from you, so that he will not hear.

For your hands are stained with blood, your fingers with guilt.

Your lips have spoken lies, and your tongue mutters wicked things.

Their feet rush into sin;

they are swift to shed innocent blood.

Their thoughts are evil thoughts; ruin and destruction mark their ways.

The way of peace they do not know; there is no justice in their paths.

They have turned them into crooked roads; no one who walks in them will know peace.

So justice is far from us, and righteousness does not reach us.

We look for light, but all is darkness; for brightness, but we walk in deep shadows.

For our offenses are many in your sight,

and our sins testify against us.

Our offenses are ever with us, and we acknowledge our iniquities:

rebellion and treachery against the LORD, turning our backs on our God,

fomenting oppression and revolt, uttering lies our hearts have conceived.

So justice is driven back,

and righteousness stands at a distance;

truth has stumbled in the streets, honesty cannot enter.

Truth is nowhere to be found, and whoever shuns evil becomes a prey.

The Lord looked and was displeased that there was no justice.

He saw that there was no one,

he was appalled that there was no one to intervene;

so his own arm worked salvation for him, and his own righteousness sustained him.

He put on righteousness as his breastplate, and the helmet of salvation on his head;

he put on the garments of vengeance and wrapped himself in zeal as in a cloak.

According to what they have done,

so will he repay

wrath to his enemies

and retribution to his foes;

he will repay the islands their due.

From the west, men will fear the name of the LORD, and from the rising of the sun, they will revere his glory.

For he will come like a pent-up flood that the breath of the Lord drives along.

"The Redeemer will come to Zion,

to those in Jacob who repent of their sins,"

declares the LORD.

M: The Lord will come again in glory. The Spirit and the Church cry out: Come, Lord Jesus, come.

M: We commend to You—Father, Son, and Holy Spirit—all those for whom we pray, trusting in Your mercy, through Jesus Christ, our Lord.

C: Amen.
