1<sup>st</sup> Sunday after Epiphany January 9, 2011

Jesus appears as the Christ, the Anointed One. The titles "Christ" and "Messiah" both mean "The Anointed One," and they describe how God prepared Jesus for his mission. At his baptism, God anointed Jesus with the Holy Spirit and with power and declared him to be the Son of God—the one anointed to be the Savior of mankind.

Prayer of the Day: Father in heaven, at the baptism of Jesus in the River Jordan vou proclaimed him your beloved Son and anointed him with the Holy Spirit. Keep us who are baptized into Christ faithful in our calling as your children and make us heirs with him of everlasting life; through your Son, Jesus Christ our Lord, who lives and reigns with you and the Holy Spirit, one God, now and forever.

First Lesson: Isaiah 42:1-7 "Here is my servant, whom I uphold, my chosen one in whom I delight; I will put my Spirit on him and he will bring justice to the nations. He will not shout or cry out, or raise his voice in the streets. A bruised reed he will not break. and a smoldering wick he will not snuff out. In faithfulness he will bring forth justice; he will not falter or be discouraged till he establishes justice on earth. In his law the islands will put their hope."

This is what God the LORD says—

he who created the heavens and stretched them out, who spread out the earth and all that comes out of

who gives breath to its people, and life to those who walk on it:

- "I, the LORD, have called you in righteousness; I will take hold of your hand. I will keep you and will make you
- to be a covenant for the people and a light for the Gentiles,

to open eyes that are blind,

- to free captives from prison
- and to release from the dungeon those who sit in darkness.

Second Lesson: Acts 10:34-38 Then Peter began to speak: "I now realize how true it is that God does not show favoritism but accepts men from every nation who fear him and do what is right. You know the message God sent to the people of Israel, telling the good news of peace through Jesus Christ, who is Lord of all. You know what has happened throughout Judea, beginning in Galilee after the baptism that John preached—how God anointed Jesus of Nazareth with the Holy Spirit and power, and how he went around doing good and healing all who were under the power of the devil, because God was with him

Gospel: Mathew 3: 13-17 Then Jesus came from Galilee to the Jordan to be baptized by John. But John tried to deter him, saving, "I need to be baptized by you, and do you come to me?"

Jesus replied, "Let it be so now; it is proper for us

to do this to fulfill all righteousness." Then John consented.

As soon as Jesus was baptized, he went up out of the water. At that moment heaven was opened, and he saw the Spirit of God descending like a dove and lighting on him. And a voice from heaven said, "This is my Son, whom I love; with him I am well pleased."
