#### A THANKSGIVING LITANY (remain seated)

- M: We give you our thanks and praise, O gracious God, that you have led us to know ourselves for what we really are and therefore we say, "Be merciful to me, a sinner."
- C: Before you, God, the Judge of all, With grief and shame I humbly fall. I see my sins against you, Lord, My sins of thought and deed and word. They press me sore; to you I flee: O God, be merciful to me! (CW 306:1)
- M: We give you our thanks and praise, O gracious God, for the gift of your Son, our Lord Jesus Christ, who gave himself into death that we might have life with you forever.
- C: Let us all with gladsome voice, Praise the God of heaven, Who, to bid our hearts rejoice, His own Son has given

To this vale of tears he comes, Here to serve in sadness, That with him in heav'n's fair homes We may reign in gladness. (CW 64:1-2)

- M: We give you our thanks and praise, O gracious Lord, for the gift of your Word, through which we have found peace, comfort, conviction, assurance and hope.
- C: God's Word is our great heritage And shall be ours forever; To spread its light from age to age Shall be our chief endeavor. Through life it guides our way; In death it is our stay. Lord, grant while worlds endure, We keep its teachings pure Throughout all generations. (CW 293)
- M: We give you our thanks and praise, O gracious God, for the priceless gift of faith by which we have been made your children and heirs of your kingdom.
- **C**: Salvation unto us has come By God's free grace and favor. Good works cannot avert our doom; They help and save us never. Faith looks to Jesus Christ alone, Who did for all the world atone: He is the one Redeemer. All blessing, honor, thanks, and praise To Father, Son, and Spirit, The God who saved us by his grace All glory to his merit! O Triune God in heav'n above, You have revealed your saving love; Your blessed name be hallowed! (CW 390:1,6)
- M: We give you our thanks and praise, O gracious Lord, for the gift of life and health, money, homes, family, friends, civil

peace and protection, and the abundance of our earthly blessings.

C: Praise to God, immortal praise, For the love that crowns our days; Bounteous source of ev'ry joy Let thy praise our tongues employ. All to thee, our God, we owe, Source whence all our blessings flow.

> Peace, prosperity, and health, Private bliss and public wealth, Knowledge with its gladd'ning streams, True religion's holier beams. Lord, for these our souls shall raise Grateful vows and solemn praise. (CW: 612:1,3)

- M: We give you our thanks and praise, O gracious God, for the richness and healing of your comfort when our hearts are heavy and the cross overwhelms us.
- C: No danger, thirst or hunger, No pain or poverty, No earthly tyrant's anger Shall ever vanquish me. Though earth should break asunder, You are my Savior true; No fire or sword or thunder Shall sever me from you. (CW 419: 6)
- M: For all these and countless other blessings to body and soul which are new to us every morning, we unite our hearts and voices in songs of praise and thanks:
- C: Praise to the Lord, the Almighty, the King of creation! O my soul, praise him, for he is your health and salvation! Let all who hear Now to his temple draw near, Joining in glad adoration. (CW 234: 1)
