SURPRISING WORDS FROM OUR SAVIOR'S PASSION

The opening hymns and songs of Christian worship mean to "gather" individual Christians into a worshiping assembly. What the traditional service does with hymns, canticles, and opening liturgy, this Lenten gathering rite does with contemporary song and responses.

#### ENTRANCE SONG

The choir introduces the refrain. The congregation repeats the refrain and sings it again as indicated.

**C:** Amen. (spoken)


## **CONFESSION - LORD, HAVE MERCY - ABSOLUTION**

M: As we prepare to celebrate the mystery of Christ's love, let us confess our sin and ask the Lord for pardon and strength:

C: Holy and merciful Father, I confess that I am by nature sinful, and that I have disobeyed you in my thoughts, words, and actions. I have done what is evil and failed to do what is good. For this I deserve your punishment both now and in eternity. But I am truly sorry for my sins, and trusting in my Savior Jesus Christ, I pray: Lord, have mercy on me, a sinner.

The choir sings the verse. The congregation repeats the last phrase as printed below.

- 1. Lord Jesus, obedient in the dessert: Lord, have mercy.
- 2. Christ Jesus, the promise of salvation: Christ, have mercy.
- 3. Lord Jesus, the flood of living water: Lord, have mercy.



M: God, our heavenly Father, has been merciful to us and has given his only Son to be the atoning sacrifice for our sins. Therefore, as a called servant of Christ and by his authority, I forgive you all your sins in the name of the Father and of the Son ♣ and of the Holy Spirit.

C: Amen. (spoken)

All sing the refrain once more.
